Key issues identified

- General acceptance of queer people, but heteronormativity persists in the Luxembourgish society.
- There are not enough LGBTIQ+ bars and diversified social spaces for queer people.
- LGBTIQ+ Freedom Zones send a positive signal as safer spaces for LGBTIQ+ individuals.
- Municipal administrations and politics are often unaware of LGBTIQ+ issues.



What participants expect

- More training on LGBTIQ+ topics for municipal staff and politicians.
- More consistent dialogue between ministries and LGBTIQ+ associations to achieve tangible progress beyond symbolic gestures.
- Communes should more actively share information about LGBTIQ+ issues.
- LGBTIQ+ organizations should set aside differences and work together toward common goals.
