Key issues identified

- The queer community stays very discreet as most do not feel safe enough to be more visible.
- Trans & non-binary people must repeatedly ask for correct names/pronouns, often facing mockery.
- Some staff members refuse inclusivity training, even when needed to handle discrimination.
- LGBTIQ+ research in the humanities is often discouraged or dismissed.



What participants expect

- The university must go beyond legal compliance and actively create a safe, inclusive space.
- Mandatory inclusivity training for everyone who teaches.
- Increase visibility (e.g., Pride flags, inclusive digital signatures).
- Involve students at every stage of decision-making.
