# Key issues identified

- Queer women struggle to find their space even within LGBTIQ+ and feminist groups.
- Many “queer” events are actually centered mainly around a gay male audience.
- Coming out still means weighing the consequences.
- Lesbophobia ranges from verbal violence to physical threats.
- Queer women protect themselves by stepping back from discriminatory or threatening interactions.



# What participants expect

- More spaces specifically for queer women and FLINTA people.
- More listening to lesbian voices in politics and LGBTIQ+ organizations.
- Feminist groups should truly reflect all women.
- Less gay-male-centred culture, more lesbian culture.
