Key issues identified

- Disillusionment regarding the country's openness to LGBTIQ+ topics.
- Being non-native in Luxembourg and queer makes it harder to connect with local communities.
- Language can be a barrier, yet access to Luxembourgish courses is difficult.
- “Vivre-ensemble” events focus on ethnicity and nationality while sexual orientation and gender identity are generally overlooked.



What participants expect

- LGBTIQ+ rights should be enshrined in the Constitution.
- “Vivre-ensemble” policies should include LGBTIQ+ issues.
- Stronger political advocacy by LGBTIQ+ associations.
- More queer activities and spaces in the north of the country.
- But queer communities should also be more active to support such activities.
