# Key issues identified

- White heteronormativity makes queer people of color invisible.
- Chinese queer women face intersectional discrimination.
- Language barriers amplify feelings of exclusion, even in queer spaces.
- Coming-out at work is an issue for Chinese queer people working in Chinese firms in Luxembourg.
- The discriminatory behavior of some compatriots enhances their mistrust towards Chinese communities.



# What participants expect

- LGBTIQ+ organisations should be more present in intercultural spaces and offer multilingual activities.
- Chinese community groups should become more inclusive of sexual and gender diversity.
- Promote safe workplaces that are committed to anti-discrimination.
- Easier access to and renewal of permanent or long-term visas.
- Create a self-managed social group for Chinese queer people.
