“A lot of things happen culturally, virtually or digitally but you don’t see them really when you go through Luxembourg-City, you don’t see queer culture when you go through the country.”



Key issues identified

- Luxembourg lacks a diversified cultural and social scene for LGBTIQ+ people, especially for non-binary people and queer women.
- Cultural productions (plays, books, movies) and institutions remain largely heteronormative.
- A fragmented cultural scene, divided between Luxembourgers and non-Luxembourgers.
- No central hub for accessing information on queer events and culture.



What participants expect

- Safe and inclusive queer spaces to explore culture.
- More LGBTIQ+ awareness in cultural institutions.
- Promote queer arts and artists in mainstream culture.
- More small-scale cultural initiatives by LGBTIQ+ associations.
- A central platform for queer events and culture (e.g. online agenda).
