# Key issues identified

- Feeling tolerated rather than fully accepted.
- Being treated differently, not 100% included.
- Constant vigilance in public spaces (avoiding holding hands, fear of comments).
- Self-censorship at work, at home, in public.
- Not always safe to be fully out.
- Persistent stereotypes (e.g., sexualisation of lesbians, disgust toward gay men).



# What participants expect

- Effort must come from everyone, not only LGBTIQ+ people.
- More queer spaces in daily life.
- A more ambitious, active government.
- Regular consultation of LGBTIQ+ associations for political projects.
- Less division, more collaboration between LGBTIQ+ associations.
- Recognition and support for volunteer work.



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
